How do we know it's Autumn?

What happens to trees in Autumn?

The leaves change colour and fall off the tree as they die.

What happens to the weather?

It gets colder and wetter. It also starts to get darker.

VOCABULARY

Autumn: the season that comes after Summer

Weather: changes in the air around us such as rain, wind, sunshine, warm and cold.

What colours are best to use for an Autumn picture?

What Colours are the leaves in Autumn?

Red, yellow, brown, gold, orange.

How can we change the colours of paint?

When you mix two colours together it changes the colour.

VOCABULARY

Warm colours: warm colours are made up of reds, oranges and yellows

Colour Mixing: where 2 colours are mixed together to make a different colour

What is hibernating?

When animals have a long sleep for the winter.

What do animals do to get ready for hibernating?

They collect food and make a nest.

VOCABULARY

Hibernate: a long winter sleep **Nest:** a warm dry bed to sleep in.
