<i>What do Christians believe about Incarnation?</i>		<i>Where is the Earth in Space and what is beyond?</i>
<p><u>What do Christians believe about Jesus as the messiah?</u> Christians believe that Jesus is the Messiah because through his crucifixion and resurrection he brought salvation to humankind.</p> <p><u>What do Christians mean by the word salvation?</u> In Christianity, salvation is the 'saving human beings from sin and its consequences, which include death and separation from God.'</p>		<p><u>Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.</u> 'Rotation' refers to an object's spinning motion about its own axis. 'Revolution' refers the object's orbital motion around another object.</p> <p><u>Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.</u> The Moon orbits the Earth once every 27.3 days. The Moon orbits the Earth in an oval-shaped path called an ellipse. Because of this shape, the Moon is sometimes nearer and sometimes further away from Earth</p>
<p>Incarnation- an embodiment in flesh of a God among the people on Earth. Messiah- For Christians this means 'the promised one' who will deliver them from their sins. Saviour- a person who save someone from difficulty or danger.</p>		<p>Geocentric-The belief that the Earth is at the centre of the solar system and everything rotates around it. Heliocentric- The belief that the sun is the centre of the solar system and everything rotates around the sun.</p>

<p><u>What does the word semiotics mean?</u> It is the study of hidden signs and symbols, their colours and use or interpretation.</p> <p><u>Describe a luminary.</u> Something that gives out a beautiful light.</p>	<p><u>Who was Gustav Holst and what is he famous for?</u> Gustav Holst) was an English composer and was a music teacher for over 20 years. Holst is most famous for his orchestral suite The Planets.</p> <p><u>What is a graphic score and how is it used?</u> Many composers use graphic scores instead of traditional music notation to record their musical ideas. A graphic score uses images, shapes and pictures instead of notes.</p>	
<p>Semiotics– hidden meanings we associate with different shapes or colours. Abstract-Art without form, non-realistic and representing a concept. Luminaries– a lighted glow from the inside.</p>	<p>Musical Terms- a description of the qualities of the music such as pitch, tone, dynamics, duration, tempo and rhythm. Crescendo/diminuendo- Gradually getting louder/gradually getting softer.</p>
