	How is the weather in Cornwall different to the Arctic? In Cornwall we have four seasons with different weather. In the Arctic there are only two seasons of winter and summer. The Arctic is mostly cold.	
Vocab	Weather- what it feels like outside right now, it could be hot, cold, sunny, rainy, cloudy, windy, or snowy.	
	Seasons- the four different times of the year with unique weather, temperatures, and daylight.

Where do animals live?		
FACTs	What is a habitat? A habitat are places where an animals or plants live.	
	Do all animals sleep at night? Diurnal animals sleep at night and nocturnal animals sleep in the day.	
Vocab	Habitat - A place where something lives. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive.	
	Nocturnal - an animal that is awake during the night and asleep during the day.	
Expressive Arts and Design/Music		
How can instruments make high pitch and low pitch sounds?		
FACTs	What instruments can make high pitch and low pitch sounds? Some brass, woodwind and percussion instruments such as pianos, guitars, trumpets and xylophones can make high pitch and low pitch sounds.	
	What are untuned percussion instruments? Percussion instruments that do not play different pitches (e.g., tambourine, drum, triangle).	
Vocab	Pitch- a high or low sound.	
	Percussion - instruments that make sound when struck, shaken, or scraped.
