FACTs	What do plants need to grow? Plants need water, light and a suitable temperature.
	What do plants grow from? Plants can grow from seeds, bulbs and cuttings.
Vocab	Roots - take the food and water to the rest of the plant.
	Stem - main body of the plant that carries the food up to the leaves.

How has farming changed over time?

FACTs	What is different about the machinery that farmers use? Farmers now use tractors and machines but in the past they used animals and hand tools.
	What difference has this made to farming? Farmers can farm more land, look after more animals and use more machines.
Vocab	Past — the time before now eg: yesterday, last year, 100 years ago.
	Machinery — tractors and tools that are powered to help dig and lift.

Expressive Arts and Design/Design Technology
What makes a healthy smoothie?

FACTs	Where does food come from? Fruit comes from plants or trees Meat comes from animals
	How do we prepare ourselves for preparing food? We wash our hands with soap and water.
Vocab	Smoothie - a thick, blended drink made from fruits or vegetables with a liquid base like milk, yogurt, or water.
	Hygiene - keeping clean, particularly washing hands before preparing food.
